

OSSU 2021 RETURN TO PLAY PROCEDURES

Mandatory attendance at the pre-season managers meeting at which time the following procedures will be announced in an effort to adhere to local and state guidelines:

Each person must accept the responsibility to stay home if symptoms are present or if there has been known exposure to illness. Respect everyone else's health, not just your own.

Spectators who arrive together should sit together and distance themselves from other groups.

Players may wear protective masks if there is no interference with the safety of the game.

For distancing purposes, players may stand outside the dugout but not on the field of play.

Limit sharing of bats and other equipment. Bring hand sanitizer and wipes to clean.

Clear the dugout completely prior to the next team entering. Additional time will be allowed between games to ease the traffic flow of players and spectators.

One manager from each team at home plate for the coin toss. Only the manager may speak to the umpire regarding the game while observing the distancing guidelines.

Avoid all possible personal contact during play. NO handshakes or high fives. No team huddles.

NO team water cans. NO sunflower seeds. NO spitting.

When at the concession stand, maintain distancing from others in line and stay off the service counter. No refills.

Limit of 6 people at one time in office area and maintain distancing guidelines.
